

Dear EPSSE 2025 participants,

We look forward to hosting you in Paris soon!

The welcome words from the EPSSE on the first day and the General Assembly on the last day will take place in **Room 100** of the **Centre des Colloques**, which is the first white building you see on Place du Front Populaire, where the metro station is located. It's also where you can register from 8:30 am on Wednesday to get your badge. The **Pre-Conference Workshop** on June 10th will take place all day in **Room 50** of the building. Please note: Only the speakers will be provided with lunch at the Pre-Conference; however, there are many restaurants, bakeries and supermarkets nearby (including a university restaurant in the Bâtiment Recherche Nord building). The **Wine Reception** will also be held in the foyer of the Centre des Colloques on Wednesday evening at 6 pm: it is located straight ahead as you enter the building.

The various conferences will take place in the **Bâtiment Recherche Sud (Rooms 0.015, 00.31, 00.032 and 00.33)**. The Bâtiment Recherche Sud is just a few minutes from the Centre des Colloques, on the left-hand side of the building. **All coffee breaks will take place in Room 0.015**. Please note: On the third day, Room 0.033 will be replaced by Room 0.031 in the same building.

Lunches on Wednesday 11th and Thursday 12th will be held on the **sixth floor of the Bâtiment Recherche Sud**. You will need to take the lift after passing through a door with a badge reader. We will be there to open the door for you. However, if you are running late, you can exchange an identity document for a badge at the reception desk in the hall (hence please remember to bring an identity document with you). **NB.** Lunch on Friday 13 June will take place in a new area: the Patio in the **Bâtiment Recherche Nord**. It is a few minutes' walk straight ahead.

When you arrive at Campus Condorcet, you can connect directly to the **Campus wifi** (ID: Campus Condorcet Colloques, password: Campus93!). The easiest way to get to Campus Condorcet is to take the **Metro (line 12)** to the **Front Populaire** stop. The campus is also served by buses: 139, 153, 239, 302 and 512. There is also a Velib station on Place du Front Populaire and a cycle park on the campus.
